1. Location : Tour de Bretagne / Staging cities et dates :

- Saturday, September 5th : St Malo St Quay Portrieux
- Sunday, September 6th : St Quay Portrieux Perros Guirec
- Monday and Tuesday, September 7th and 8th : Perros Guirec Brest
- Wednesday, September 9th : Brest Roads : Olympic triangle
- Thursday and Friday, September 10th and 11th : Brest Piriac sur Mer
- Saturday, September 12th: Piriac sur Mer La Trinité sur Mer

2. Organizing authorities :

- FFVoile
- Ligue Bretagne de Voile

3. Rule :

- The Tour de Bretagne à la Voile will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- The International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGS)
- L'Arrêté du 30 septembre 2004 modifiant l'arrêté du 23 novembre 1987 relatif à la sécurité des navires. The September 30th, 2004 ordinance modifying the November 23rd, 1987 ordinance regarding ships safety
- The Tour de Bretagne à la Voile is a rank 3 regatta of the Class rules for the Figaro Bénéteau.

4. Eligibility :

Open to any Figaro Bénéteau 2 yacht which conforms to all specifications of the current Figaro Bénéteau Class Rules, and whose Crew, Skipper and Owner are members in good standing of the Figaro Bénéteau Class

- They must hold a valid measurement certificate for 2009.
- The Tour de Bretagne is ran in doubles.
- Yachts and one representative of the crew must report with the organization from Wednesday, September 2nd, at 9 AM in St Malo, Sablons Harbour.

5. Measurement session :

A measurements session will be held prior to departure.

6. Parking :

- Boats parking will be free for participating boats for the duration of the event in the participating marinas.
- Participating yachts will benefit from a free parking in St Malo harbour from **Sunday, August 30th**
- Participating yachts may park for free in La Trinité until **Wednesday, September 16th**
- Boats arriving by road transportation will be required to inform shall inform the organizing committee as soon as possible.
- Presence of the skipper or a legal representative will be compulsory during boat handlings.

7. Conditions for registration and entry :

- Deadline for the arrival of the yacht and one legal crew representative :
Wednesday, September 2nd, 9AM
- Race instructions will be handed upon registration on September 2nd and 3rd, 2009.
- The entry deadline is Wednesday September 2nd, 2009, 9AM.
- Fees :
 - Regatta fee is 500€ per boat prior to July 1st
 - The fees for entries received between July 2nd and August 31st will be 700€ per boat
 - The fees for entries received after September 1st will be 800€ per boat
- Disclaim :
 - Prior to July 1st – Fees will be reimbursed with a 20% deduction
 - After July 1st, no fees will be reimbursed

8. Scoring :

- Low point scoring system.
- All races will be applied the same coefficient which will be 1.
- No race shall be withdrawn for the scoring calculation.
- Overall ranking shall be calculated by adding the scores for each race.
- In case of ex æquo in final ranking, decision between the competitors will be made in compliance with addendum A.8 of the RRS.
- The crew that will total the lowest scoring points shall be proclaimed winner of the Tour de Bretagne à la Voile
- Penalties will apply according to the race instructions and the 2009 Figaro Bénéteau Class Rules.

9. Prizes :

30 500 euros distributed in appliance with the single-handed scale defined by the Figaro Bénéteau Class.
